



# REVIEW – Law 7

- Equal periods
  - How long are adult matches?
  - Can length of periods vary?
- Time kept by referee
  - For what reasons may time be added?
  - May *extend* time for what purpose?
  - Does the referee stop the clock?
- Half-time
  - What if 1 team wants it & other doesn't?
  - Up to 15 minutes - how long normally?



# REVIEW – Law 8

- Coin toss
  - brief and cordial
- Who calls it?
  - Traditionally the visitor calls it.
- What choice does the winner have?
  - Which goal it will attack
- What will the loser get to do?
  - Kick off in the first half.



# REVIEW – Law 8

## **At the kick-off:**

- Where are the players?
  - Players are in their own half of field
- How far away are the defenders
  - at least 10 yards from ball
- When is the ball in play?
  - When it is kicked forward
- Can a goal be scored directly?
  - Yes
- Must there be a signal for play to start?
  - Yes



# REVIEW – Law 8

- Any infractions (except 2nd touch)

**Retake the kick**

- 2nd touch by kicker

**IFK for opponents**

- Dropped ball for undefined stoppages
  - Where does the dropped ball take place?
  - When is the ball in play?
  - What happens if a player “double touches” the ball?
  - Who can participate? How many can?



# REVIEW – Law 9

- If the ball is on the penalty area line, is it in the penalty area?
  - Yes
- When is the ball out of play?
  - When the whole ball has crossed boundary line, or
  - Play has been stopped by the referee
- What if the ball hits the referee?
  - Play continues



# REVIEW – Law 9

- What other times is the ball still in play?
  - When it rebounds from either Assistant Referee, if they are on the field of play
  - When it rebounds from a goalpost
  - When it rebounds from a crossbar
  - When it rebounds from a corner flagpost



# REVIEW – Law 10

- How is the winner determined?
  - The team scoring more goals wins
- Is a goal scored if a team kicks a free kick into their own goal?
  - No, restart with corner kick
- Is a goal scored if the ball goes into their opponents goal on a throw-in?
  - No, restart with goal kick



# REVIEW – Law 10

- State an example of a ball that is “not legally propelled” into the goal.
  - From Indirect Free Kick
  - Into team’s own goal from Free Kick
  - From throw-in
- Can a goal be awarded if it is stopped on the way to the goal by an outside agent?
  - No, restart with dropped ball
